Chess Express - Vincent Marr

This class is for beginning and experienced chess students who would like to increase their ability by learning advanced strategies from a chess master. Mr. Marr has taught chess in the Seattle area for over 11 years. He has been the head chess coach at the Evergreen School, Lakeview Elementary and at the University Child Development School. Chess provides the opportunity to learn problem solving, concentration and self-discipline (and it's fun too!).

Mandarin Chinese - Katie Lin

\$75 (each class - specify beginning or advanced)

Katie Lin is a native Chinese instructor. She is a fun loving person and has worked with children for over ten years. Her students will learn emotions, family members and locations as well as more basic conversational Chinese through hands-on activities. Students will celebrate Chinese festivals through food, songs, crafts, etc. This is a fun class to learn Chinese and to become familiar with a different culture.

Anyone Can Be An Artist - Flint Crumpacker

Everyone can create and enjoy art. Using drawing, painting, and sculpture students will learn to create and explore their own visual worlds both in and outside of the classroom. Students will learn how to show space, proportion and distance by drawing people, self portraits, and landscapes using water color, ink, collage and acrylic painting. New activities added to the class include making animals and environments, and cartoons. The purpose of this class is for everyone to develop their skills and confidence as artists and to have fun making art. Flint has taught art in Seattle for 13 years. He has a Masters of Fine Arts degree from the University of Washington & is a professional landscape artist.
